Please note that specialist teachers will be delivering Outdoor Learning and computing on a Wednesday afternoon. PE takes place on a Tuesday morning and will be delivered by Premier Sports and Computing by Mrs Boddy. The children will be expected to bring their PE kits to change into and we ask that the PE kits be sent home regularly so that they can be washed to avoid potential contamination.

We understand that this year is going to be very different for your children returning to school and that they (and you) may have some anxieties about work missed during lockdown. Please be assured that we will be preparing to teach both content from the end of Year 2 and our Year 3 curriculum this year.

### Homework

Last year, Shinewater introduced the termly 'homework menu', which set a variety of tasks related to our topics for children to choose from. We will be continuing with that this year and our homework menus will be sent home soon.

We will also send home spelling lists, which consists of a set of Year 1/2 words and a set of Year 3 words. The aim is that children are familiar with these by the end of the academic year. The children will be tested on their spellings at regular intervals and we appreciate your support in this area.

In addition, we will expect the children to continue to learn their times tables and to continue reading. Reading is particularly important because being a good reader allows the children to better understand all their lessons.

### Other Admin Bits

We keep current 'hometime arrangement' lists, which are up-to-date as far as we are aware with arrangements for the end of the day for your child. We are unable to let children go (by themselves or with an adult whose name is not on our list) unless we have your permission to do so.

A quick reminder too that each child should have a water bottle in school with them every day. It is important that children have enough sleep as it makes a huge difference to concentration and energy levels. Breakfast in the morning is another aid to concentration and well-being.

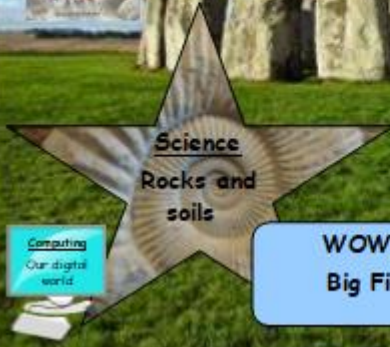
